## Treasurers Report

Mr Brodie reported the balance of the account was £3410.89. £2500 of these funds are ringfenced for the Wellpark Project, which means there is a balance of £910.89 left.

### Matters Arising from Meeting held 1<sup>st</sup> July

Work Site, Dippen Hill – All work has been complete and all excavation work re cables have now been reseeded and are starting to grow.

Overnight Parking – There has been a decrease of overnight parking within the area.

Harbour Signage, Carradale – Signage will hopefully be erected by the end of September. Cllr Redman said he will follow this up if signage is not complete by this timeframe.

Bus Stops/access – All access points/pavements have been raised and there has been a new bus shelter fitted at Saddell. New timetables still need updated in all bus shelters.

EK REG Update – No update, carry forward to October meeting.

## **Matters Arising**

Blue Bins – Mr Brodie informed that everyone in Kintyre will be getting a new blue bin delivered hopefully within the next few weeks. This bin is for the new fortnightly recycling service which will commence in October. Everyone should receive a leaflet with details but can also go onto the Argyll and Bute Council website for more details.

Abbeyfield House Walkway – Mr Brodie advised Jolyon Gritten, Access Manager has confirmed the Council has received evidence from thirty people and they are in the process of collating all the information. He will get back in touch once he hears back from the Council's Legal Department.

Speeding through Peninver – Cllr Colville advised there has been concerns raised about the speed of drivers passing through Peninver. The Police Speed Warden has been contacted and has been asked if the speeding equipment can be prioritised to be situated in Peninver.

Road Survey - Mr Brodie advised he has asked for a road survey to be carried out for the B842 and B8001. There has been some issues with regards to cars backing onto the main roads when people are waiting for the ferry's, mainly the Tarbert-Portavadie ferry.

Hogweed – This was raised as a concern as it can be very dangerous for livestock. Cllr Armour advised it is getting worse within the area, but the concerns have been raised with Argyll and Bute Council.

Future Meeting Dates - Cllr Colville and Cllr Armour asked if all future EKCC Meeting dates could get sent to them. Mr Brodie advised he will action this and said the EKCC Meetings are usually held on the first Thursday of every month.

#### AOB

Mr Brodie advised Mr McPherson from EKCC would like to explore the community's thoughts regarding having a war silhouette in each village (Peninver, Carradale and Saddell). This item will be carried forward to the next meeting for discussion.

Mr Brodie advised Mr McPherson would also like to explore the possibility of having a defibrillator located in the disused BT telephone box at Saddell. This item will be carried forward to the next meeting for discussion.
